Now as the strike is over.

Few important repercussions of it

- 1. It clearly appears that, the planning was poor and the execution/conduction was even poorer.
- 2. National Media gave no attention, when one of the largest PSU was on all out strike, it means our media management is poor. One thing is for sure, you cannot blame GOI for news suppression. There are lot of media houses always willing to go against present GOI in Delhi itself, like ndtv and others. कई उदाहरण हैं इस बात के, कुछ मीडिया हाउस के पास सरकार को क्रिटिसाइज करने के अलावा कोई दूसरा काम ही नही है।आप पांच मिनट ndtv पर सुनो, आपको लगेगा कि आप पाकिस्तान में हैं।There are few media houses, who take money to do news. Our union/ association have hell lot of money, but for what? They can even hire PR agency for this.
- 3. Big leaders have little knowledge about the issues, particularly the technological ones. Even they went bit far too much regarding 4G Spectrum. Why they want 4G? License is costly. Existing 2100 MHZ frequency with additional 5 MHz could be utilized, only thing, we need equipments.
- 4. ITS and DOT officers are have great amount of intellectual dishonesty. Leaders need to deal with this tactfully. There is feeling among employees that leaders were mostly for pension settlement with maximum % of fitment.
- 5. People do not have sympathy with BSNI. They want voice/video/data free or cheaper, No matter who gives this, BSNI or Jio or Airtel or Voda.
- 6. Dangerous one: DOT could realize that even after 03 days strike by 1, 70,000 employees, services were as usual. Voice, video, data, lease line, hot line, bank, LIC, all working fine. It means these people are worthless, so VRS/CRS/ 58 years can be implemented and 40000 employees can't be sent packing.

Employees as well as union have lost their reputation to some extent.

This is an insult to our experienced employees.

- 7. March to PMO on 06 March is childish decision, it's not possible.
- 8. No MP is now interested in your memorandum now, as election is round the corner. So 28 Feb. has no meaning.
- 9. Minister is busy in his election related issues now and therefore, he naturally is no more interested आप ढूंढते रह जाओगे उसे।
 - 10. On 21 Feb. DCC meeting is there. We can hope something from there.
- 11. Cabinet will sit last on 27 Feb., so that would be the last opportunity to remove affordability clause. Cabinet note must reach there.
