OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Minimum Government - Maximum Governance - Simplification of Government procedure for abolition of affidavits and promotion of self-certification.

In the context of Government's initiative for Minimum Government and Maximum Governance, Department of Administrative Reforms and Public Grievances (DARPG) had requested all Ministries/Departments to undertake *an exercise for abolition of Affidavits and certification by Gazetted Officers and adoption of self certification instead.*

2. *A meeting was taken by Secretary/Special Secretary, DARPG on 17.7.2015 to review the progress made in this regard. Based on the discussions held during the meeting, all the Cadre Controlling Authorities in DoT are requested to take the following actions urgently and submit a compliance report to DDG(C&A) by 30.7.2015:*

- (i) Since Aadhar Card has the unique identification number of a citizen/official, the same should be embedded in the service book, in the Pensioner's card, in the CGHS card and also in the bank account maintained by the officials. To facilitate this, the DoT website has been linked with UIDAI website. A circular may, therefore, be issued to all Officials informing them that the facility of getting Aadhar Card number is available in all the States throughout India so that all the officials who have not enrolled them for Aadhar Card may get themselves enrolled and obtain the Aadhar Card.
